Makin' it Real: Moving Beyond the Basics

The American Council for School Social Work (www.acssw.org), in collaboration with Tulane University, is hosting the 6th ACSSW Advancing School Social Work Practice National Institute January 17 - 19, 2018 on the beautiful campus of Tulane University, New Orleans. This conference is an interactive, participatory experience in which practitioners, researchers, leaders in school social work, and university academics share their expertise and practice wisdom.

Presentation Proposals are now being accepted online at www.acssw.com. (see last page for summary of application)

- **Conference Theme - Makin' it Real: Moving Beyond the Basics** - Proposals must demonstrate intent to provide practitioners with practical applications of theory, research, evidence based practices and data driven interventions as well as innovative and/or new promising initiatives critical to current student needs. Proposals do not need to be rigorous research projects, however all presentations must demonstrate a clear relationship with evidence-based, data-driven, or research-based interventions and studies.
- ACSSW seeks a variety of presentations that may be considered introductory, intermediate or advanced in terms of content and application to practice:
 - Introductory** - for audiences that lack prior knowledge and/or experience with application of presentation content.
 - Intermediate** - presumes knowledge/experience with application of introductory concepts and focuses on intermediate content/applications.
 - Advanced** -presumes intermediate knowledge/experience with application of intermediate concepts and focuses on advanced content/applications.
- Please limit presenter bios to 300 words, presentation titles to 12 words, and presentation descriptions to 500 words. Proposals must also include 3 measurable objectives: "Participants will be able to..." Proposals must also include estimated timed agendas.

Presentation Categories & Descriptions:

Intensive Workshops (3.0 hours) A session that offers hands-on interactive training or in-depth information for individuals interested in gaining advanced knowledge and/or skills related to the topic.

Conference Sessions (1.5 hours) A session that encourages active participation and discussion and allows individuals to gain new knowledge, skills, and enhance understanding of a topic.

Presentations of particular interest include, but are not limited to evidence-based practices in mental health assessment & interventions, crisis response, individual and group counseling, trauma-informed care, violence, suicide, eating disorders, substance abuse, self-injury, homelessness, immigrants, child abuse/neglect, poverty, pregnancy prevention/support, truancy/dropout prevention, restorative practices, PBIS/RtI, FBAs & BIPs, Adverse Childhood Experiences, neuroscience, family/parent engagement, peer leadership programs, cultural competency/diversity, collaborative partnerships with community agencies, documenting school social work services, data-based decision making, consultation skills, leadership & advocacy roles of SSWers, social justice, boundaries & ethics, program development/evaluation, and grant seeking.

Deadline for submissions is September 8, 2017

Notification of accepted proposals will occur generally within 2 - 3 weeks after submission and no later than September 20, 2017

Presenters must have received approval and/or funding to present by their employers no later than September 10th.

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Presenter Registration Discounts:

Accepted presenters for the ACSSW NOLA 2018 Advancing School Social Work Practice Institute are entitled to a discount on conference registration fees as follows:

- 20% discount on regular registration fees (see below) for presenters presenting a total of 1.5 hours
- 30% discount on regular registration fees (see below) for presenters presenting a total of 3.0 hours

Accepted presenters will be able to register online www.acssw.com starting July 1st. The full conference brochure will be available on or near September 20th.
